FANS (EXTERIOR CEILING)

Cautions

- I. These are *minimum* standards. Property owners are encouraged to consider designs and materials which will result in a higher quality installation and appearance.
- II. Prior to installing a ceiling fan confirm the mounting location will support the weight of the fan. Some, but not all, Celebration homes were built with additional blocking above ceiling outlets to accommodate a fan.

Standard Conditions for ALL Exterior Ceiling Fan applications

- A. Fans must be UL listed (indicated by either the UL trademark or text in brochure, on packaging or on the product).
- B. Fans must be attached to the ceiling or to a horizontal overhead structure such as a pergola rafter.
- C. Fans which will be installed beneath a solid surface (e.g., a porch ceiling) must be “**damp**-rated.” Fans which may be exposed to water (e.g., installed in a pergola which may be rained upon) must be “**wet**-rated.”
- D. Exterior surface wiring to fans is not permitted for residential structures; all electrical connections must be contained within the structure.
- E. Light kits added to ceiling fans must have the same exterior moisture rating as the base fan. Bulbs used in light kits must be clear or white. Light shades, if present, must be clear, white or off-white for white fans. Except for decorative trim, blades and blade attachments (thus the canopy, downrod and motor unit) must all be the same color.
- F. All fan blades must identical design, material, texture and color.
- G. All fans on the front of the home must be the same style and color scheme.

Fan Color Options

- H. Fans should be white with white blades and may be used on all architectural styles. Other colors may be submitted for consideration.

Accessories

- I. Decorative pull chains may be attached to a ceiling fan.
- J. No other attachments may be added.

Maintenance

- K. Routine maintenance includes, but is not limited to:
 1. Cleaning to remove dirt, algae/mildew, rust, etc.
 2. Painting surfaces which are suitable for painting to maintain the original color.
 3. Replace fan blades if warped, cracked, discolored, rusted or missing.
 4. Replace lamp shades if damaged or missing.
