#### **Cornerstone Enhancements**

- **Renewable Initiatives**

- **Solar** – No discussion
- **Car Charging Systems** – Information was presented that Duke Energy has a program available to a limited amount of applicants to expand the number of EV charging stations in the area at no cost. An application will need to be submitted online and has been passed on to management.

- **5G Networks** – Discussion on the current signal strength throughout the community, especially the area between South Village and Artisan Park. Information needs to be presented to all cellular networks about the lack of coverage in the immediate areas. There is interest in looking into new cellular antenna sites and options to increase availability to residents. Tom Hull will research repeaters which may help reduce the number of brown/black spots.

- An inquiry was made on when the next emailed survey would be sent out in an effort to possibly engage the community on the EV charging stations conversation. Management will provide information.
- Direction was provided to management to review and submit the Park + Plug application from Duke Energy prior to them closing out submissions.
