MINUTES

The Dog Park Committee meeting was called to order at 5:30 P.M. on February 17 by Paul Battaglini (Chairman). Also present were Meredith Brown, Ralph Doucette, Jill Furlong and Sue Davis . Committee member who was not present was Lez'lie Reynolds. Representing Grand Manors was Danny Mann, Parks and Recreation Coordinator, and Braylan Senquis, Operations Manager. The meeting has been properly noticed and was ready to proceed with business.

Adopt the Agenda

- Ralph motioned to adopt the agenda for today's meeting, Jill seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Approval of the Minutes

- Ralph motioned to approve the January 27, 2022, Dog Park Meeting minutes, Jill seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Dog Park Maintenance Update with Operations Manager

- The Operation Management updated the Dog Park Committee on the maintenance of the Large Dog Park Section. The Operation Manager stated have received the proposal from Yellowstone but still waiting for the proposal from Nuleaf for re-sodding and re-graveling the park in such areas as well as restructuring the irrigation system to fit the current design. Cameras are up and running along with video. Boxes are being switched to all magnetic. Still working on Celebration standard signage for closure of the dog park every third Thursday of the month.

Doesn't want the park closed for an excessive amount of time (up to them at the owner discretion). Residents wanting to know how the committee members were chosen & getting to make these decisions. Paul asked Danny & Bryan to discuss amongst management on the closure of the dog park.
