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Design Guidelines

A supplement to the Celebration Pattern Book

Approved by CROA Board of Directors on 12/17/13.
Effective for applications received on or after 12/17/13.



ROOFING

A wide variety of appropriate roofing materials are available and suitable for many of Celebration's architectural styles, including:

- Metal, 5-V crimp with exposed fasteners (color matched), non-striated design – for Coastal, Colonial Revival and Victorian style homes.
- Metal, narrow width standing seam, concealed fasteners, non-striated design – for Classical, Coastal, Colonial Revival, French and Victorian style homes
- Corrugated metal – for Coastal style homes
- Shingles – Architectural style (5 tab Asphalt), fiberglass (slate profile) – for French style homes
- Shingles – Architectural style (5 tab Asphalt), fiberglass (shake or standard style) – for Classical, Coastal, Colonial Revival, Victorian and Craftsman style homes
- Shingles – Metal – for Victorian style homes
- Shingles – Wood – Coastal, French, Victorian and Craftsman style homes
- Flat Clay tile, Slate or synthetic slate – Classical, Colonial Revival style homes
- Flat Clay tile, Slate or synthetic slate with “V” ridge tiles – for French style homes
- Tile, red terra cotta barrel “mission” style – for Mediterranean style homes

When it is necessary to replace only a **portion of roofing** (for example, to fix a leak or repair other damage) temporary shingles may be installed immediately to prevent further damage. Before permanent shingles are installed, a sample of a full shingle and a piece of the existing shingles must be submitted to the ARC Coordinator for approval. Approval will be made for reasonable matches as determined by the ARC. If the area of the patch is greater than 25% of the roof plane then the shingles must match the existing shingles to the extent that a reasonable person unassisted by an optical instrument cannot distinguish where the new shingles stop and the existing shingles start – otherwise the entire plane must be replaced.

If you are replacing your **entire roof** with the same material (e.g., asphalt shingle), style (e.g., triple tab) and color (e.g., Weathered Wood) simply submit the ARC Application with a sample of the old and new roof materials.
